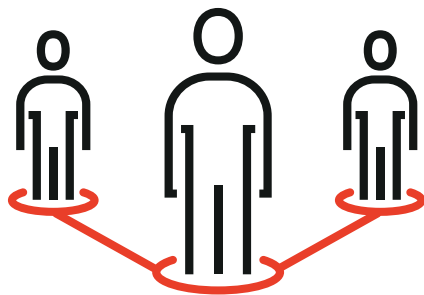


## FUNDING YOUR EDUCATION

# TRANSITIONING FROM FOSTER CARE TO COLLEGE

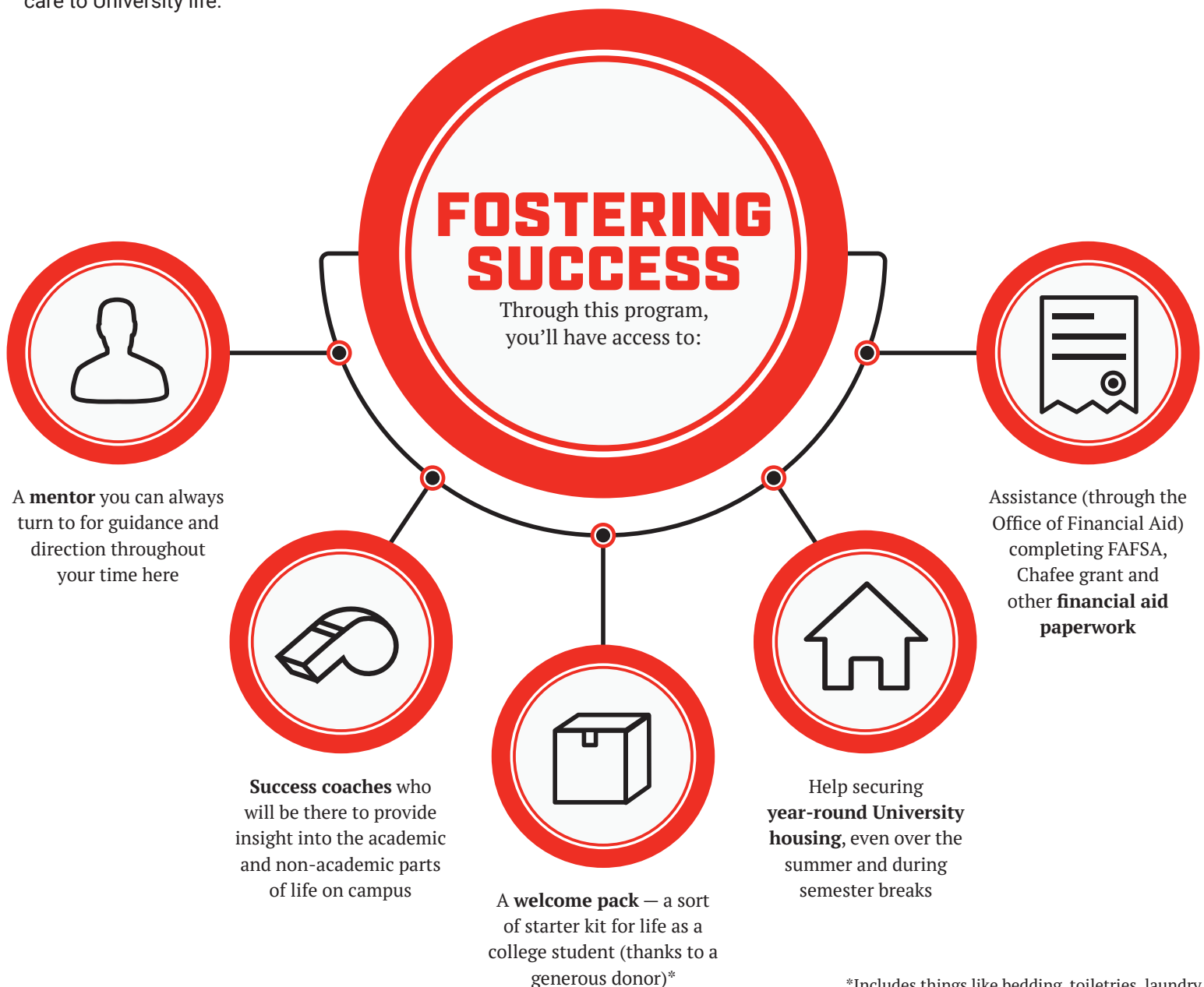
